NHSD Institute of Information Technology

NHSD established Institute of Information Technology in collaboration with La Compte Registered Firm in December 2021. Since that time, NHSD and La Compte have successfully trained and practically guided 100 apprentices in graphic designing, web design, database management. The first batch of diploma in information technology was enrolled in November 2023. These apprentices were from very socioeconomically deprived locations and were trained in both theory and practicals of diploma in information technology through a scholarship.

The apprentices successfully completed freelancing projects as they were enrolled on to various online freelancing platforms as a means of sustainable, skill based livelihood. To date, we have enrolled more than 40 apprentices on to the platforms FivR and Upwork.

BAHAWALNAGAR HAS BEEN FLOODED!!



In August 2023, the district of Bahawalnagar in Punjab was completely inundated with water, resulting in a significant loss of property, food, and economic welfare. The people of the area became internally displaced, having no food, shelter, or clean drinking water.

The worst affected were the women, children and elderly of the area, having no place to call their home, rendered poverty stricken because of the floods which happened during the time of the summer harvest.

NHSD has been providing support in the best way possible, whilst also appealing to all possible donors for support. This project is ongoing, and NHSD strives towards women empowerment by not only providing support to women, but also ensuring that they are guided in the reconstruction and relief efforts that they may form shared groups to be able to assist each other.

NHSD was working with Rescue 1122 in the initial periods of the response.

THE COLLECTORS' ADMIRALTY



In collaboration with Akhuwat Cloth Bank, NHSD began "The Collectors' Admiralty" in 2019 which has established 7 libraries in Pakistan, these include:

- A central library in NHSD headquarters which includes 2500 books, the oldest from 1868 and also books published in 2022, as an open-access opportunity for Rawalpindi and Islamabad communities both to donate books rather than have them scrapped or sold to old book banks, and for elderly and younger members of the local communities that they may have access to books on premise without having to pay a substantial amount.
- Four libraries in schools located in very socioeconomically deprived areas of Rawalpindi, with one in a Montessori in Multan and one in a girl's primary school in Dadu Sindh.
- Book donations which compose of textbooks that are as per the provincial curriculum allowing school teachers and students to complete their requirements.
- Research for technical training institute of NHSD.




Since 2021, NHSD has been working in Sindh towards the support of the local communities. The people had lost their homes due to the devastating floods of that year and since then they have been abandoned by the provincial government of Sindh. Tharparkar has been the worst hit area followed by Keti Bandar. The former has abandoned and left in disarray by the provincial government because of the Hindu majority population, whilst the latter has been left to fend for itself because the population is composed of fishermen and fisherwomen.

NHSD has been working in close conjunction with the people and has successfully empowered the local population of Tharparkar to not only reconstruct 130 houses using locally sustainable materials, but also install 30 solar cells on their reconstructed houses. NHSD achieved this milestone through the benefaction of King Baudouin Foundation/ Solvar Solidarity Fund Belgium, Global Giving US, Give2Asia US and individual donations.

NHSD has a very close connection with Keti Bandar, having worked with the communities there to achieve the Guiness World Record for most mangrove trees planted in a single day. NHSD, on its own initiative, dispatched its team to Keti Bandar where the people were provided food rations and their plight was emphasized through fund raising campaigns. NHSD is working with Global Giving towards poverty alleviation and women empowerment of the people of Keti Bandar.
