

The Vision

In 2018, a group of like-minded young enthusiasts with an unsatiable hunger of contributing towards the society while taking a "Path less travelled" had taken an initiative in the field of education having in mind and the rural children as the prospective beneficiaries. The seed had been sown in their minds when they had undergone the B.ED course together and had increasingly realized the vacantness of the conventional educational system which fails to shape a child as a total man connected with the environment around and with the global community at large which Rabindranath Tagore had envisioned. Hence, in 2019, Kolotan was set up by a group of dreamy-eyed youth of the local area. The vision of Rabindranath Tagore had got strongly imbibed in their psyche that 'The object of education is to give man the unity of truth'.

Vision

We have therefore been imparting holistic education to children who would be able to connect the myriad dots of life, in terms of connecting themselves with nature, with community and with the global civilization so that they can become a 'Global Citizen' in the true sense of the term. We want them to be connected with the global community, hold their heads high and express themselves without fear. The principle which has been embedded in our approach; to quote Tagore once again 'Education should be part of life itself and must not be detached from it and be made into something abstract'.



We are fortunate that brilliant Educationists, Scientists, Economists, Industry Managers and Artists from different creative fields have come forward asour mentors in forging ahead our initiative and giving shape to our dream. Their level of commitment demonstrates that they had never given up their dreams and have found an avenue in the form of 'KOLOTAN' to channelize their energy. We feel much energized with their inclusion and we are confident that we are being able to set our direction.

We have chosen an area in Mirhati, Amdanga Block (Barasat, North 24-Paraganas) in West Bengal which is essentially lacking in opportunities in terms of infrastructure, education, primary health and hygiene and providing the people avenues of eking out livelihood. In structuring our educational model, we wanted that we should be visible as different from other schools in the area which provide text-based academic education only and not holistic education which has been deeply imbibed in our educational model. In terms of affordability also, these schools are not within the reach of the majority of the population. We on the other hand have been providing a holistic education which is affordable and within the means of the common people.



Why different

Kolotan is a space for children to give expression to their imaginations and encourage free thinking. Kolotan intents to offer thoughtfully designed quality education to children from diverse background.

Following are the features that make Kolotan different from others educational institutions:

- In Kolotan children are always free to ask questions and provided enough flexibility to choose their work. Hence classes are not very structured.
- Kolotan does not believe in compartmentalizing different subjects and interweaves them effectively to ensure joyful learning .Art, craft, music, clay modelling, language, maths and science are interwoven with equal importance.
- Children learn to connect with nature routinely rather than occasionally.
- Kolotan strives to connect discussions in class with daily life situations, seasonal changes and social awareness.



- To address the issue of mental health the teachers in Kolotan are in constant touch with the families of the children.
- Children of senior classes are often given the responsibility of taking care of their juniors to create a good bonding among different age groups.
 - Kolotan ensures children to be self- reliant without imposing any regimentation on them.
- The teachers/facilitators regularly assess the children but grades are not awarded as Kolotan does not encourage competition .A detailed report on the child's overall development is given to the guardian twice a year.
- The fee structure has been kept low to make it accessible to marginalized children too.



Breaking the confines of the narrow walls;' The dream School-Building'.

To start with, 'Kolotan' as a school was housed in a rented local shelter. However, with more and more parents from the local community taking interest in the non-conventional educational approach, more and more children got enrolled with the school. As a logical corollary, it has become imperative that we have a school-building of our own. In conceptualizing the design of the school-building, we wanted that narrow confines of the walls should be broken so that the children can have a physical and emotional connect with the environment.

One of the key features of the school design is the use of local materials and skills. The design of the school emphasizes the use of natural light and ventilation to create a comfortable and healthy learning environment. The school spaces are designed to make maximum utilization of natural light and ventilation with a minimum number of walls. The design also incorporates double-height spaces for interaction between levels and niches in the cob walls for reading, creating dynamic spaces that encourage play and exploration in children.



This not only helps to create a sustainable and eco-friendly school but also empowers the community by providing opportunities for skill development and economic growth. The school will focus on up scaling existing craft forms such as embroidery making, quilt making, and saree weaving, providing a platform for the women in the community to grow and develop their skills. The design of the school-building has taken into reckoning that after-school hours can be utilized for community activities, creating a strong sense of place where the community can be emotionally connected with the initiative.

Also, it is important that our School which is structured around a different educational model gets affiliation of West Bengal Board of Education for which a school-building in conformity with the required standards is but imperative.



The Support which we look for

The first priority ahead of us is construction of the school-building of our own. While the narrow confines of the flat wherein Kolotan school is presently housed is completely in anathema with our philosophy of breaking the barriers and getting the children connected with the environment, the payment towards the monthly rental has been also creating a huge and recurrent pressure on our finances.

In our effort to impart low-cost and affordable education to the children of the local community, we had kept the fees-structure comparatively quite low.

We have kept a panel of brilliant teachers who have a conviction about the educational model which we have envisioned and can impart education to the children in synchronization with the educational model. However, due to our financial constraints we are not being able to suitably remunerate them.

Added with this, we have a team of very enthusiastic non-Teaching administrative personnel as well to whom we are not being able to suitably remunerate.

Like many other social institutions across the globe, COVID-19 induced different spells of lockdowns between 2020 and 2022 had put up a roadblock in our journey which we had started in 2019 and had played a havoc with our efforts.

The roadblocks created in the form of serious financial impediments is required to be removed so that we can move ahead with giving proper shape to our dreams.

We are looking forward to your partnering in our effort which is weaved around an inclusive societal growth and come forward in generously contributing in terms of financial support so that we are able to surmount the financial hardship which we are faced with.
